9 <u>Unitary Councillors</u>

Gwilym Butler reported as follows;

- His Annual report will be ready by the end of the week.
- There was a discussion on Boundary Changes. The first to be addressed will be the Unitary Boundaries ideally each Councillor will have c 3,500 voters on 'his Patch'. Process starts in October 2022 with a 12 months review period. The whole process and new Boundaries in place for the election in May 2025. The review of Parish Boundaries will follow. Some Parishes will merge so we need to focus on our way forward. An open public will need to be called to obtain the views of the Electorate.
- The Ofsted review of Shropshire's performance of Children in Care was favourable. Some 85% of Budget is dedicated to Care in The Community.
- Gwilym is the Cabinet Officer responsible for Finance. Budget for year is £594m gross but only £40m available to spend on all services. Hope to have a balanced budget for the coming year. There is an anticipated deficit of £50m for 2024. We need fairer funding from Central Government. Rural population with large land mass low population are disadvantaged by the current rules.
- A perfect Storm is approaching with the cost-of-living crisis. A social group is being set up to advise people in need.
